Mayor Cazares Handling Project

Major Target: To remove Cazares from any position from which he can inhibit the expansion of Scientology or United Churches in the Base area.

Primary Targets:

1. GC Flag
2. To remove him from public office and discredit him as an opinion leader
3. AG Flag, AGPR FLAG, AG I FLAG, AG L Flag
4. Targets checked out on and understood by those involved, and GAGes utilized as indicated.
5. Program supervised by Poms US; minor debugging by Programs Officer, Flag, AG alerted to major bugs and liason with Poms Sup
6. Targets being completed on schedule

Vital Targets:

1. Do not endanger the legal and non political status of the C of S or U
2. Good security on actions taken which could be interpreted as political must be maintained so that these do not trace back as being political action of the Church.
3. Ensure that actions taken are based on local surveys and not just ideas of what we think the local community thinks.

TARGETS FOR PR

Operating Targets : Front Group not overtly connected to Sch

1. Find out the issues which Cazares is using as part of his campaign for Congressional Office and which he has used while running for Mayor, or party while in office as Mayor. AGPR May 30

2. Do a survey on the major issues he has used. This is to be done on a true cross section of the community, and the sub-public also being kept track of. Find out what the public feeling and tone level on each issue is. AGPR May 30

3. Do a survey to find out what is wanted and not wanted for a congressman/politician in the local area _____ AGPR 5 June
4. Place Gas Member Ron Wiedoff as I/C of the campaign to force Cazares out of office as mayor in line with the current attacks being made against him by members of the City Council. DONE _____ AGPR
5. Target and get done a petition campaign to be done by Wiedoff to collect petitions calling for the Mayor to step down since he is running for office. Wiedoff should present these petitions to the City Council at the Thursday 15 April meeting. He should be drilled and ready with press statements so that a strong attack line is carried at the event. _____ DONE AGPR
6. Review the success of the petition action and target further petition actions to get the mayor to step down if these seem warranted. If done, this should include events for the use of these petitions to carry our attack line. _____ AGPR 5 June
7. Get the targets in #6 done. _____ AGPR 8 June
8. Have political enemies of Cazares contact (not by a Scientologist) in regard to the need to get him to step down as Mayor while running for congress so that he will not misuse the Mayor's office as a personal political platform. Get suggestions and elicit help from these people in what actions can be taken to get Cazares to step down as Mayor. _____ AGPR 20 June
9. Plan and do up targets based on any ideas or data gotten in #8 and get these targets carried out. _____ AGPR 25 June
10. Liase with legal to find out what the law is in regard to Cazares remaining the Mayor while running for office. If there is any ambiguity the law use this in your actions as another reason Cazares should step down. _____ AGPR 25 June
11. Survey to find out what groups, businesses and organizations would be opposed to the issues being supported by Cazares which were found in Tot 1. Target and carry out a subproject to have individuals contact the groups and solicit support for opponents of Cazares or just for the idea of stopping him. Base all this on the fact that he will be very bad for the area and use the issues which he supports and which the group contacted opposes as an example of why. Solicit active support and political donations where legal and so forth. (Don't get our people collecting political donations, etc. but motivating others to pitch in and support a selected opponent of Cazares). Get the selected opposition candidates to Cazares well supported. _____ AGPR 15 August
12. Determine if Norm Bowles will file an ethics commission complaint against Cazares as he has been planning to do. If Bowles cannot be used to do this, locate a suitable comparable replacement and have this person file the complaint. _____ AGPR 20 June

13. Get any other persons possible to file complaints with ethics committee against Cazares. These complaints must be based on actual offenses and must not appear to all be solicited by us. The persons filing them must be willing to stand behind them on their own. The idea is to get more than one complaint filed in order to motivate the commission into doing a real investigation of Cazares.

AGPR 1 Jul

14. Target and carry out a subproject to get a letter writing campaign to the Sun and Times done. The letters should call in various ways for Cazares to step down as Mayor while running for federal office, there should be various reasons stated for why he should do so and the campaign should in no way appear controlled. Some letters should be hostile and others more favorable but still all wanting him to step down. Get at least 100 such letters generated, some can even come from Tampa.

25 July

15. Target and carry out a letter writing campaign to members of the city commission calling for the mayor to resign from office as he is running for federal office, will make the commission a partisan body, not have enough time to be Mayor. Ask the commissioners in many of the letters to take action. Get the most letters sent to the most active commissioners but approximately 20 sent to each. Be sure they are different and appear spontaneous so that the commissioners will begin to think that public opinion is heavily in favor of the mayor stepping down.

16. Target and carry out a subproject for 5 upstat persons to work in the campaign of the strongest challenger for the Democratic nomination against Cazares. These could even be residents of the FH as long as they are acting as individuals. See that they have needed tech to interject into the campaign to make it effective.

17. CONDITIONAL: If Cazares should get the Democratic nomination for congressman arrange for a group of approximately 10 upstat persons who are well briefed to go to work for the campaign of Bill Young. Run these persons so that they greatly increase the effectiveness of the campaign and ensure a victory for Young.

(Complete by election)

18. Begin at once regardless of whether Cazares has the nomination, to get one good person into a position of influence in the Young campaign organization. If necessary this person can be used to supply tech suggestions, strategy or even data to Young to ensure a defeat of Cazares.

19. Target and carryout a subproject which researches and keeps track of Cazares political events and speeches and without appearing like harassment, ensure that there is always opposition present at his events to ask embarrassing questions or at least make it known that he is not liked by everyone. Use these opposition actions to the best advantage but they must not connect to us or appear to be other than legitimate citizen opposition.

AGPR Going fullblast by 30 June and in maintain

20. CONDITIONAL: Find out if there is any substance to the story that we were told that Cazares is disliked for getting the homes of blacks in the slums condemned while he was in office (perhaps he is disliked just because it was done under his administration).

AGPR 30 May

21. CONDITIONAL: If this story has substance and there is legitimate hard feeling over this, target and execute a subproject which forms a front group with no connection to us to pull together all the people who are upset over this issue and get them attacking Cazares, staging press events which get coverage running against Cazares image of being for the poor workers.

PR TARGETS FOR DIRECT SCIENTOLOGY RELATED ATTACK ON CAZARES

22. Hit Cazares with a major article in the next CW Freedom using an issue of his (anti-religion stand or some such).

23. Be sure Cazares is prominently mentioned in the Watergate parody which is being done on the Sun and will be handed out around CW.

AGPR 10 June

24. Call Ardith Hilliard and sell the Cazares Secrecy in our deposition story which was not used.

AGPR 1 June

25. In liason with Bl follow up on the two leads we have received regarding the Blackburn family backing, and backing for Cazares from the St Pete Times.

AGPR 5 June

26. Make use of anything found.

AGPR 10 June

27. File a complaint before the city commission from the Church in regard to Cazares withholding portions of his correspondence on the Church from the commission, and acting covertly as the mayor in his trips to Tallahassee. Further the line on which he has been attacked in the commission that he has acted without proper consultation with other members.

AGPR 7 June

28. Get the press interested in covering the contents of the mayor's deposition in our suit against him. Hang this on the fact that this is the depo that he wanted the court to make secret. Without issuing a release make copies of the depo available to selected press terminals along with

suggested (verbally) story lines.

AGPR 10 June

29. Maintain your pro-Son letter writing campaign to the Sun to counterbalance the entheta campaign which the Mayor is keeping going.

30. Liase with AGL to determine if we should directly file a complaint with the ethics commission and if this is advisable see that it is done in liason with AGL.

31. See that the voter registration project is executed and all possible of our voters are registered and that they all vote against Cazares in the primary and final election. (It would be good to assess if it will be possible to have the remainder of our voters register as democrats so they can vote against Cazares in the primary where individual votes means more--the only point against this is that the rolls are public and would reflect that we had stacked the party registration of our people, however, this may not be important.)

32. Prepare and execute a press conference announcing the filing of our amendment in the suit of ours against the mayor, which will expand the complaint against him and charge conspiracy.

I have the following to report as compliances on your Gpgm 393 on Cazares.

Target 37

OK

A project called Tacless was mocked up by Dir Br I and carried out, during the course of this project we came across information which did prove a connection between the St. Pete Times and Cazares. There were several times where he was at the Times meeting with execs there including Nelson Poynter, Betti Orsini, Eugene Patterson. There were also connections between Cazares and the Times attorney's as they had copies of his suit with us sent from St. Pete to Arant, Lintner etc, law firm in D.C. More recently Cazares met with the editorial board of the St. Pete Times, as a candidate, along with Young, to get both of their views on issues and they went and endorsed Cazares for Congress after these interviews.

So, a connection between the Times and Cazares has been established and attached as evidence is a report with the connections listed, this report is part of a compliance report to the Tacless Project mentioned above. A copy of the Tacless Pjt file folder is also attached as evidence that a subproject was done up and the product was gotten.

OK

On this target we understand that letters were sent to the City Commissioners which asked for Cazares' resignation. These letters as it turns out are public record, and from our understanding of what was communicated to them the letters were very unfavorable to Cazares.

Attached as evidence is a recent weekly report which reports our news of the letters being sent to the City Commissioners. As you may not know, they are very down on him and recently there was a vote to get him out of office and the vote was so close that only his vote saved him from being ousted from office.

OK
This target was very effective in actual practice and as we understand it there has been a lot of internal dissension and chaos inside Jaramas campaign headquarters. Things like low morale, disorganization, calls into his headquarters from unhappy voters, his campaign brochures which were illegal showing up in Young's headquarters, charges that Jaramas conducted illegal campaign handouts and that he violated Federal election laws have also been going around his headquarters and also in Young's. Rumors that he should resign have plagued his headquarters and his own people have even said he should do that.

Attached as evidence is a recent weekly report which mentions the rumors of his resigning and his bad financial condition in his campaign.

OK
A handling was sent to HQ on 2D and this was in fact OK'ed. The handling did take place. As we understand it the word did get back to the son of the person he was involved with and there was quite an upset there on the out 2D.

The rest of the handling didn't take place due to the ineffectiveness of the first part of the handling. Although there was an upset the son did not believe it was true. We picked up a rumor that someone from his school spoke to him and he said that it wasn't true and it was a dirty trick someone played on him and that was all. The handling didn't go any further, also due to the fact that the rumor of the out 2D was never verified, and the effects desired with the terminals involved, however, the handling was approved and the steps were done to the point outlined in the handling where the effect created was conditional on the rest being done.



As we understand it this newspaper poll came to the attention of the State Democratic people while they were at his hqs and from what we can pick up around town this had a large effect on their decision as to give him money or not.
