As things are going really well with Ritz we should reinforce his area and make it even tighter.



In the midst of your handling of Dick's post, I am hesitant to make this request but it really is needed to get a wrap up on the tech scene with Ritz, per 1830.

As his classification has to be to a large extent relatively overt, I need some reasonable activities for him during the time he was attached to the standing wave. 
Logan's comments on John Veleen were that he "is fairly strong and level headed in appearance. His information seems well documented". (Pg. 40, 4)

The tech is in very well. Contact is set up with coded phone rings at which point depending on the number the c/s goes and meets the auditor at a predetermined meeting place. The place is in tech as well and meetings are brief and they usually cover data responsibly obtained by the auditor or the transfer of withholds which were obtained by the auditor; and at that time further orders and direction are given to the auditor on priorities.

We recently went over this particular line per GO 1530R we wanted to make extra sure that tech was in on this person. His classification has been worked out also which was completed when I got the data I had brought back with me from LA here that finished up the steps on that cycle.
